Another Time Another Planet deals with the process of collection of used cooking oil.

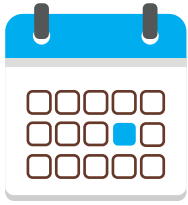
The main objective of the project is to create an economical sustainable platform of employment in order to **provide women who are victims of genre violence with a job.**
